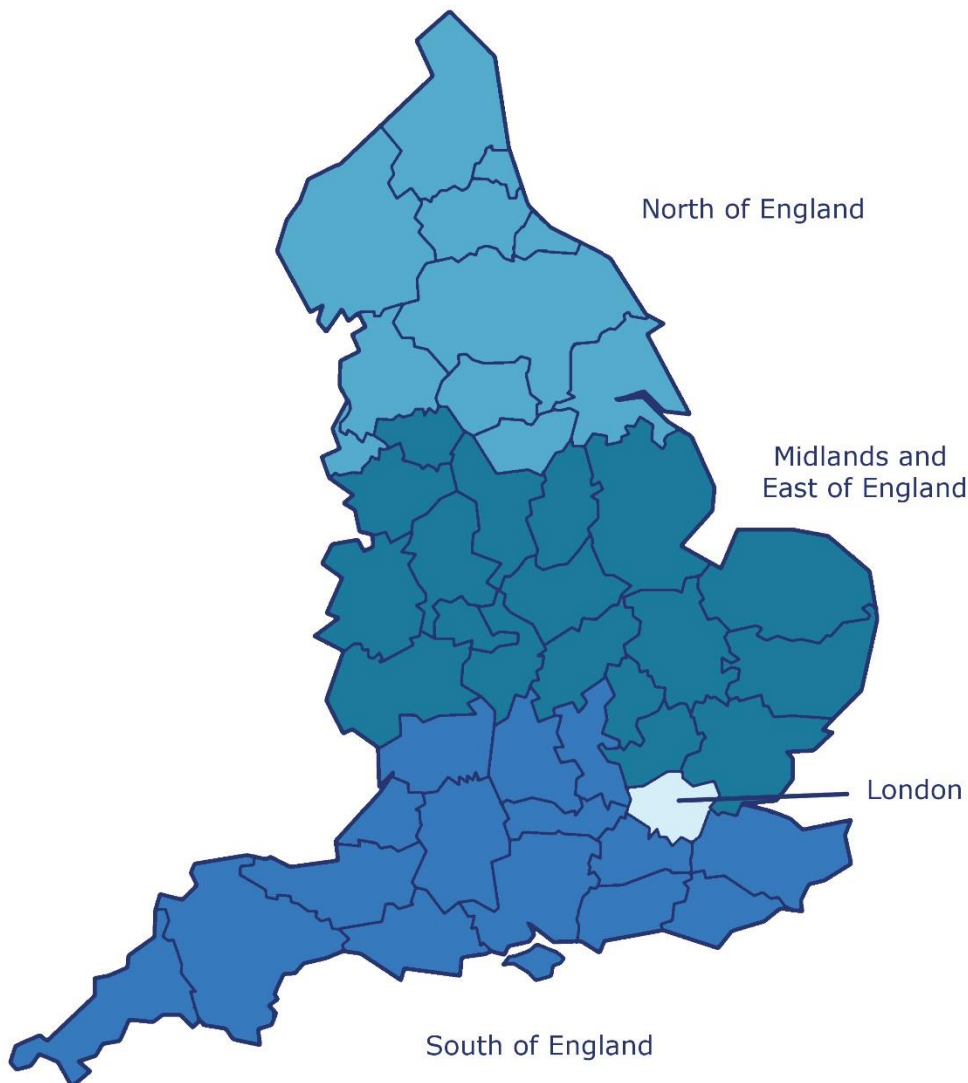


NHS England Commissioning Board Regions

- Cardiovascular (including cardiac, stroke, renal and diabetes)
- Maternity, Children and Young People
- Mental Health, Dementia and Neurological Conditions
- Cancer

Strategic Clinical Networks are split into the following geographical areas:

- North East, north Cumbria and the Hambleton & Richmondshire districts of North Yorks
- Yorkshire & The Humber
- Greater Manchester, Lancashire and south Cumbria
- Cheshire & Mersey
- East Midlands
- West Midlands
- East of England
- Bucks, Oxon and Berks
- South West
- Southampton, Isle of Wight, Portsmouth, Hampshire, Dorset/ Bournemouth & Poole
- South East Coast
- London
